The Role

Reporting to the **Head of Asset Management**, with project reporting to the **Asset Manager**, the **Associate Asset Manager**, is to support the performance and delivery of success of the assets allocated to them.

The ideal candidate will be degree qualified and/or have relevant experience managing Operation & Maintenance agreements for renewable energy assets – wind, solar or BESS. Relevant experience on other energy generation or operational infrastructure assets will also be considered. An understanding of the principles of asset management and details for how technical and commercial decisions impact asset lifecycle performance is desirable.

Strong communications skills are required for interaction with internal and external stakeholders.

The role would suit a self-motivated individual who can support Atmos Renewables' goals and ambitions.

Key responsibilities:

- Support the delivery of allocated assets' P&L and related KPIs.
- Support the delivery of allocated assets' performance targets.
- Responsible for the asset reporting related to WHS, performance, commercial, market interactions and compliance to internal and external stakeholders, with support from the rest of Operations.
- Participate in the communications and interactions with allocated assets external stakeholders, including suppliers, community members, regulatory bodies and build long-term sustainable relationships.
- Support the tendering, negotiation and review of any equipment warranties and service agreements as renewals fall due.
- Management of allocated asset documentation as required by Atmos' internal systems and external requirements.
- Demonstrate strong Health, Safety and Environment values, ensuring all O&M contractor services are performed at the highest HSE standard and in accordance with all applicable legislation and regulations.
- Support to the Asset Manager of allocated assets through a risk-based asset management approach.
- Assist in the delivery of asset operation & maintenance services through the management of complex long term service agreements (O&M Agreements) with supplier partners.
- Meet asset performance targets through the management of O&M contractors.
- Provide assistance to Atmos operations team in the management of complex technical issues
- Daily analysis of asset performance, liaising with O&M contractors and reporting to the Asset Manager to prioritise and address any issues identified.
- Support the delivery of reporting of asset performance to internal and external stakeholders.

- Ensure document management on allocated projects are structured and complete.
- Analyse and interpret operational data to provide insights and identify issues, performance improvements and asset reporting.
- Support the calculation and verification of contractor reports, including availability guarantees and contractual KPIs.
- Assistance in the management of any equipment warranties in accordance with warranty agreements and processes
- Assist in the management of asset performance to ensure optimum and continuous compliant operations in accordance with the NER.
- Assist in the management of statutory and compliance management for technical matters on the operational plants, including liaising with internal and external stakeholders.

Skills & Experience

- Recognised qualifications in engineering, business, commercial or other relevant equivalent experience,
- 0-5 years of relevant professional experience in the renewable energy sector. Relevant experience gained in other sectors will be considered.
- Strong documentation/administrative skills would be highly regarded.
- Experience in (or the ability to develop) the management of services agreements for operating assets.
- Develop experience in analysis and audit of Health, Safety and Environment matters
- Knowledge of asset life maintenance planning, whilst understanding importance of balancing reliability-based maintenance with maintenance cost management
