The ideal candidate will be degree qualified and relevant experience managing operational renewable energy assets – wind, solar or BESS. Relevant experience on other energy generation or operational infrastructure assets will also be considered. A robust understanding of the principles of asset management and details for how technical, commercial and financial decisions impact asset value and lifecycle performance is essential.

The candidate must be experienced in managing complex suite of service agreements to delivery safe operations and high asset performance. This role will also take the lead and support the asset managers on high priority technical and commercial issues as they arise.

Strong stakeholder management skills are required for a range of internal and external stakeholders, including landholders, community members, regulators and suppliers.

This role will suit a strong team player able to build and manage a high performing team.

- Responsible for WHS compliance across the operating portfolio.

- Responsible for strategic management of the operating assets using a risk-based approach to value optimisation of the fleet with support from the rest of Operations as well as Finance and Engineering.
- Responsible for the collaborative and supportive line management of Asset Management to deliver a high-performing team.
- Responsible for the operational reporting related to WHS, performance, commercial, market interactions and compliance to internal and external stakeholders.
- Responsible for the communications and interactions with our asset external stakeholders, including suppliers, community members, lenders and regulatory bodies and build long-term sustainable relationships.
- Responsible for tendering and negotiation and review of any equipment warranties and service agreements as renewals fall due.
- Responsible for the management of asset documentation as required by Atmos' internal systems and external requirements.
